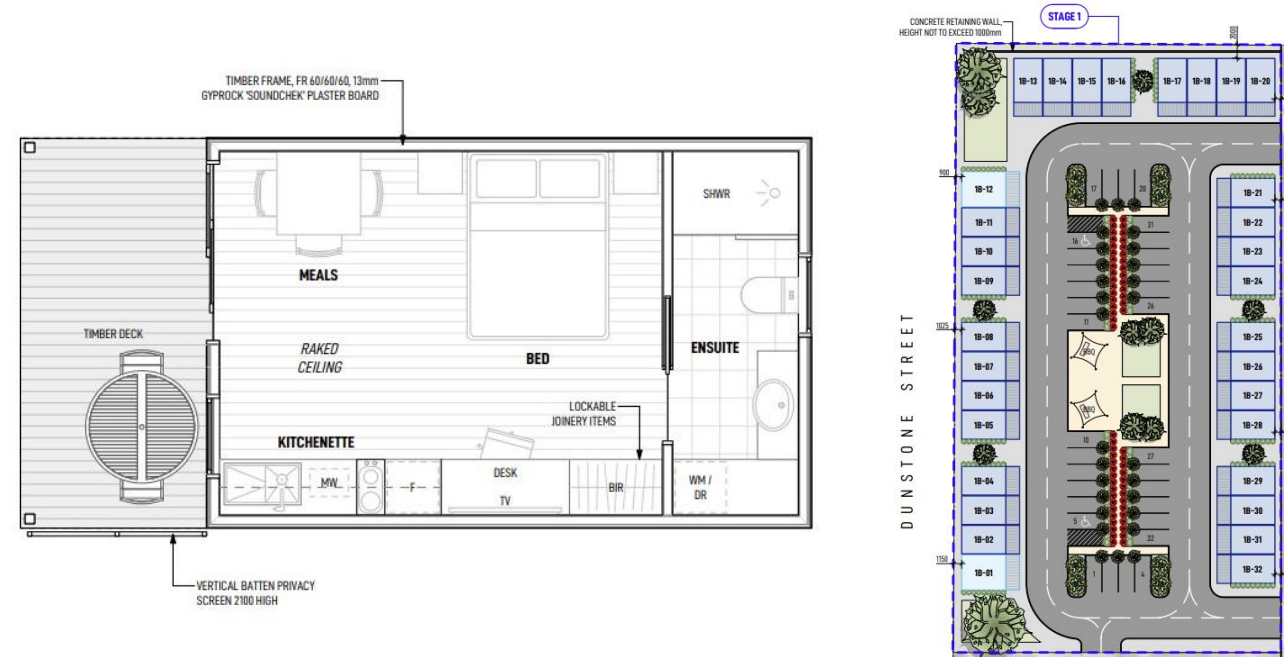

Supporting South Australia's Hydrogen Jobs Future

- 32 serviced studio cabins developed by Discovery Workstay at Whyalla to accommodate South Australia's earliest Hydrogen Jobs Plan workforce.
- Eco-friendly materials and construction methods inc double-glazed windows, solar, batteries, rainwater capture and reuse, and heat-pump hot water.
- The project's early workforce will have first option to book on-site accommodation from late 2024 until the end of 2025.



Discovery Workstay - Whyalla

Supporting South Australia's Hydrogen Jobs Future

- >\$7.6M project related capital investment in SA
- Over \$6M in regional SA supply inputs
- Directly supporting an additional c.5FTE within Discovery Workstay
- >\$6M expected GDP benefit for Whyalla community
